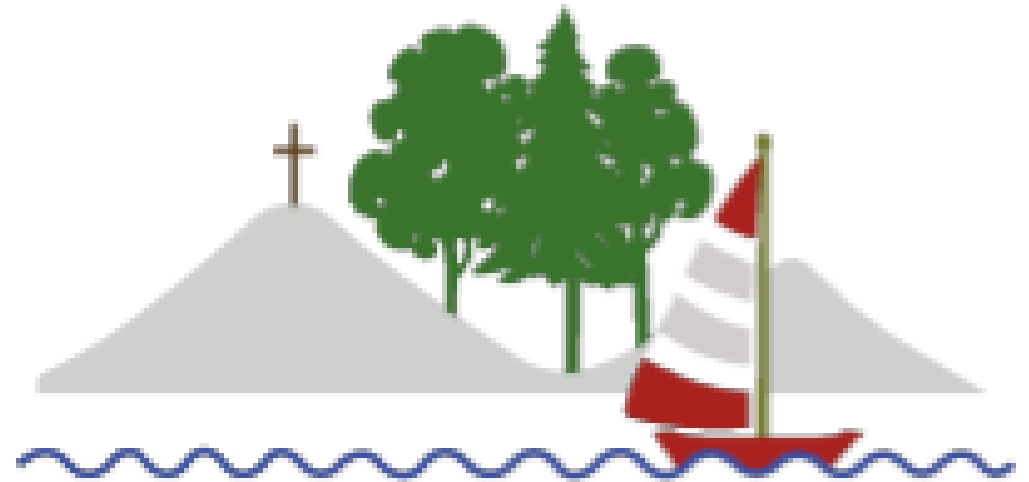

### RESERVATION OFFICE

**Safety at Calumet**— safety for all is our #1 priority at Calumet. We try very hard to keep everyone safe while visiting camp. Please observe these rules and discuss them with your family to help make your vacation a safe one.

- ◆ Observe the 5 MPH speed limit whether you are driving a car, a golf cart, or a riding bike in the campground.
- ◆ The speed limit on Ossipee Lake Road is 30 MPH
- ◆ Do Not use your cell phone while driving on camp. Reminder that the State of New Hampshire has a hands free law.
- ◆ Use the crosswalks whenever you cross the road. Always dismount and walk your bicycle across the road.
- ◆ NH state law requires all children 16 & under to wear a helmet while on a bike.
- ◆ All bikes ridden after dusk **MUST** have a headlight mounted and turned on!
- ◆ No splitting or chopping wood after dark
- ◆ Use walkways— no cutting through other camp sites.
- ◆ Campground sewer system users are required to provide an odor proof connection via hose seal or sewer adapter.

### **Resident Camp Safety**

For the safety of the children in Resident Camp, **no one** is allowed on resident camp without a guide.

Tours are available upon request at the Reservation Office in the Conference Center.

**Please** do not cross the athletic fields on your way to the beach.
